

FEE FOR PROVISION OF DATA FROM THE BURNS REGISTRY OF AUSTRALIA AND NEW ZEALAND

- The Burns Registry of Australia and New Zealand is a valuable source of data about burns patients in Australia and New Zealand. Access to the data and requests for data from the BRANZ database is subject to strict access guidelines (Guidelines for Access to Data Collected by the Burns Registry of Australia and New Zealand).
- All data summaries and analyses provided by BRANZ will incur a fee to cover the costs for staff to undertake this work.
- The minimum charge per hour of work (or part thereof) is \$100. Thus, a data analysis/report requiring one and a half hours of BRANZ time will be charged at \$200.
- The fee of \$50 per hour (or part thereof) is for basic tabulations and data extractions only. When more detailed analysis of data is required (e.g. statistical comparisons, statistical modelling, etc.), this will need to be charged at a higher rate.
- GST (10%) is also payable and the overall charge per hour (or part thereof) is therefore \$110 for a standard analysis.
- Upon receipt of a data analysis request, BRANZ will send the data requester a cost estimate to undertake the work. This will normally be within 2 weeks of receipt of the request. All data requesters must agree to these costs (in writing) before any data request can be met.
